

	<p style="text-align: center;">PRELIMINAR RESULTS OF SERVICE SUPPORT FOR RESEARCH IN INBORN ERRORS OF METABOLISM AND PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS</p> <p>English abstract: Introduction: The Instituto de Genética e Erros Inatos do Metabolismo (IGEIM) seeks to spread knowledge of EIM and train multidisciplinary teams. Therefore created in august 2008 – a support service through a free phone and e-mail – the health professionals in the investigation of EIM. Signed up partnership with the Instituto Canguru (IC) to assist in carrying out medical examinations and subsequent therapy, confirmed the EIM. Objective: To describe the initial results achieved in the first 6 months. Methodology: The health professional, to raise the diagnosis of EIM, is in contact with the IGEIM and is registered in the database. The doctor IGEIM collects data from the clinical history, the case is discussed with the multidisciplinary team and informs the consultant, by phone and e-mail, the diagnostic hypotheses and conduct suggested. The IC allows, families without resources, directed by IGEIM, the performance of alternative tests, unavailable in public health. Results: Sign up in this period of the 59 patients and of these, 4 were sent to the IC. Moved away from EIM in 17 patients, 4 had a confirmed diagnosis (Glycogenosis, OTC, metilmalônica acidemia and MPS I), 1 was the death and the others are still in diagnostic research. Conclusion: Health professionals in Brazil still have little knowledge of the EIM, then support services for the research aims to help and also for education, about EIM.
